Book 1	Daily Attendance Records -- First Term 1883-84 School Year through the term ending June 11, 1885; lists all students by name	Fall 1883 through June 1885
Book 2	List of students by Indiana county of residence, date they were admitted, how long they could attend, and whether they graduated	1898 through 1908
Book 3	Daily Attendance Records -- Begins with unknown term, second set of records begins in January 1877 and ends in June 1877. Second section of book is called Department and Attendance; records start with September 1877 and go through January 3, 1878. Last section lists General Averages (including demerits).	1877-1878
Book 4	Daily Attendance Records -- Gives grades for department, absences, and tardiness. Begins with September 1878 and goes through June 1879. Final section of book records examination scores by student for their classes, beginning with September 11, 1878 through March 28, 1879. Also lists their class standings.	1878-1879
Book 5	Daily Attendance Records -- Lists scores for attendance and department, and lists absences, starting with September 1879 through June 1880. Final section of book records examination scores by student for their classes, beginning with September 1879 and goes through June 1880. Also lists their class standings.	1879-1880
Book 6	Daily Attendance Records -- Lists scores for attendance and lists absences, starting with September 1880 through March 1883.	1880-1883

Book 7	Rules for appointed students; withdrawal notice for one student, dated January 6, 1902; List of students by Indiana county of residence, date of enrollment, how long they can attend, and whether they graduated from 1887 through 1902. Book ends with handwritten note from Irma Fitch saying she will not return to Purdue.	1887-1902	
Book 8	Preparatory Class 1884-1885 -- Entrance examination scores, whether students passed these tests and were admitted.	1884-1885	
Book 9	Matriculants 1899-1900 -- Starts with rules and regulations governing students. Contains signatures of students who, by signing, agreed to abide by Purdue's rules and regulations.	1899-1900	
Book 10	Matriculants 1902-1903 -- Starts with rules and regulations governing students. Contains signatures of students who, by signing, agreed to abide by Purdue's rules and regulations.	1902-1903	
Book 11	Matriculants 1900-1901 -- Starts with rules and regulations governing students. Contains signatures of students who, by signing, agreed to abide by Purdue's rules and regulations.	1900-1901	
Book 12	Matriculants 1901-1902 -- Starts with rules and regulations governing students. Contains signatures of students who, by signing, agreed to abide by Purdue's rules and regulations.	1901-1902	
Book 13	Matriculants 1897-1898 -- Starts with rules and regulations governing students. Contains signatures of students who, by signing, agreed to abide by Purdue's rules and regulations.	1897-1898	
Book 14	Preparatory Class 1885-1886 -- Entrance examination scores, whether students passed these tests and were admitted. Also lists student post office addresses and parent names.	1885-1886	
Book 15	Teacher's Class Record -- Political Economy recitation record of the senior class, September 1883; goes into recitation records for May and June, but no further details listed.	1883	

Book 16	Teacher's Class Record -- Recitation records for mechanical classes, shop practice, shop work, shop working, wood workers, and forging and drawing. Teacher's last name is Goss, first name initial W. Records span 1880 through 1885.	1880-1885	
Book 17	List of Students, 1896-1897 -- Listing of resident graduates, their residence, and their rooms (local address). Same type of listings for seniors, juniors, sophomores, freshmen, Winter Course in Agriculture, School of Pharmacy, and "specials."	1896-1897	
Book 18	List of Students, 1897-1898 -- Listing of resident graduates, their residence, and their rooms (local address). Same type of listings for seniors, juniors, sophomores, freshmen, Short Course in Agriculture, School of Pharmacy, and "specials."	1897-1898	
Book 19	Listing of absences from Chapel Exercises, April 3, 1883 through June 7, 1883.	1883	
Book 20	Chapel Record -- Record of chapel attendance starting September 1881 and ending October 1882.	1881-1882	
Book 21	Teacher's Class Record -- Recitation records for teacher Armette Ferris in physiology, English, history, and algebra. Records for teacher Erastus Lest (or Test) in algebra, arithmetic, natural philosophy, and physiology.	1888-1889 for Lest/Test; possibly earlier for Ferris	
Book 22	Teacher's Class Record -- Recitation records for J. C. Rollins in grammar, U.S. history, physical geography, physiology, algebra, March through June in an unknown year.	Unknown	
Book 23	Teacher's Class Record -- Recitation records for teacher with the last name of Peck in Latin and elocution.	Unknown	
Book 24	Chapel Record -- Record of chapel attendance starting for term ending December 22, 1876, and ending with fall term of 1878. Entry on last page is daily programme for the Fall Term 1877 for freshmen, sophomore, junior and senior students.	1876-1878	
Book 25	Teacher's Class Record -- Preparation Department, January 1890. Recitation record for Erastus Lest (or Test) for algebra, philosophy, physiology, arithmetic, geometry, and natural philosophy.	1890	

Book 26	Chapel Record -- Record of chapel attendance starting in September 1879 through April 1881.	1879-1881	
Book 27	Teacher's Class Record -- Preparatory Class attendance records 1890-1894.	1890-1894	
Book 28	Department of Biology, 1890-1891, Stanley Coulter. Recitation record for teacher Stanley Coulter for human body, zoology, botany, pharmacy anatomy, and geology. Recitation record for D. McDougall for an unknown class.	1890-1891	
Book 29	Names and Dates of Appointed Students -- List of students by Indiana county of residence, date they were admitted, how long they could attend, and when withdrawn between the years of 1877 through 1891. (Includes listing for George Ade.)	1877-1891	
Book 30	Attendance records, beginning September 1874 and ending June 1876. Examination records starting October 1874 and ending June 1876. Listing of students, their age in years and months, their place of birth, date of entrance, names of parents, and residence, 1874-1879, includes some billing information	1874-1879	
Book 31	Report of Purdue Academy, 1883-1884 -- Report of the scholarship and attendance of the regular students attending Purdue University Academy for September 6, 1883 through June 5, 1884. Includes examination records, whether they passed, and whether they were admitted.	1883-1884	
Book 32	Preparatory Class Records, 1886-1887 -- Listing of student names, their city and county of residence, their guardian, their high school, their examination record, and whether they passed the entrance examination. Includes their term examination scores, whether they passed, and whether they were promoted to the next class.	1886-1887	
Book 33	List of Appointments and Alternates -- Students listed by Indiana county of residence from Adams County through Marion County. Listed by name, filing date, and in force date. Majority of pages have no entries.	1908-1909	

Book 34	Pledge to not join any Greek fraternity or other college secret society, dated September 9, 1880. Signatures of students who signed the pledge. Next set of signatures dated September 8, 1881. Later pages also contain other regulations that students agree to follow. Signatures continue through 1893.	1880-1893	
Book 35	Matriculation 1882-1895 -- Contains signatures of students who pledge to follow Purdue's rules and regulations. At the beginning of the book, there are a few notes that contain not only the signature of the student but handwritten text regarding the rules/regulations they pledge to follow. Note: This book contains signatures of John McCutcheon and George Ade.	1882-1895	
Book 36	Teacher's Class Record -- Recitation records of teacher John A. Maxwell in Latin, history, English literature, 1879-1882.	1879-1882	
Book 37	President's Class Record -- Recitation records for teacher E. E. White in political economy, U.S. Constitution, intellectual science, English literature, rhetoric, and composition. 1879 only date found; other years possible.	1879 (possibly other years)	
Book 38	Teacher's Class Record -- Unknown teacher, unknown classes, unknown year(s). Students names are listed along with grade notations.	Unknown	
Book 39	Teacher's Class Record -- Recitation records for mostly unknown classes in unknown years. Some pages list Bernhard Tietz as the teacher for German in 1882. Another teacher is Alfred Kummer.	1882 (possibly other years)
